The Fox Kukri 658 is a knife of Nepalese origin used both as a work tool and as a weapon, it is heavy and slightly curved, and its particular shape with the blade curved about 20 degrees allows a center of gravity moved slightly forward to exploit the force of inertia and thus facilitate all operations required in cutting. It is also an element of the Gurka warriors equipment, warriors of Central Asia.
